1. RADICULO — spinal nerve root
4. PLEGIA — Loss (or severe impairment) of ability to move parts of the body
6. THECO — A sheath or capsule
8. TAXO — Order, coordination
11. LEPTO — Thin, slender, delicate
12. NARCO — Numbness, stupor, sleep
14. NEURO — Macroscopic structure of axons and dendrites
18. PTOSIS — Drooping or sagging
20. THALAMO — Brain's main relay center; conducts impulses between the spinal cord and the largest part of the brain
21. MENINGIO — Three protective membranes that surround the brain and spinal cord
22. CAUSO — Burn, burning
23. DURO — tough, fibrous membrane that is the Outer covering of the central nervous system
24. PARESIS — Slight (partial or incomplete) paralysis

25. VAGO — cranial nerve X (that's a roman numeral 10, not an "x"!)

2. COMATO — State of profound unconsciousness from which one cannot be roused; deep sleep
3. LEPSY — violent spasms of the face, trunk, or extremities; seizure
5. ESTHESIO — Nerve sensation (feeling)
7. CEREBRO — Largest part of the brain; responsible for voluntary muscle activity, the senses, thought, memory, and many other functions
9. CEREBELLO — Posterior (small) part of brain; little brain
10. KINESIA — Motion; movement
13. LEXO — Word, phrase
15. MYELO — Spinal cord and/or bone marrow
16. ALGESIA — Excessive sensitivity to pain
17. STHENIA — Strength
18. PONTO — Brain region in front of the cerebellum and between the medulla and the rest of the brain;
