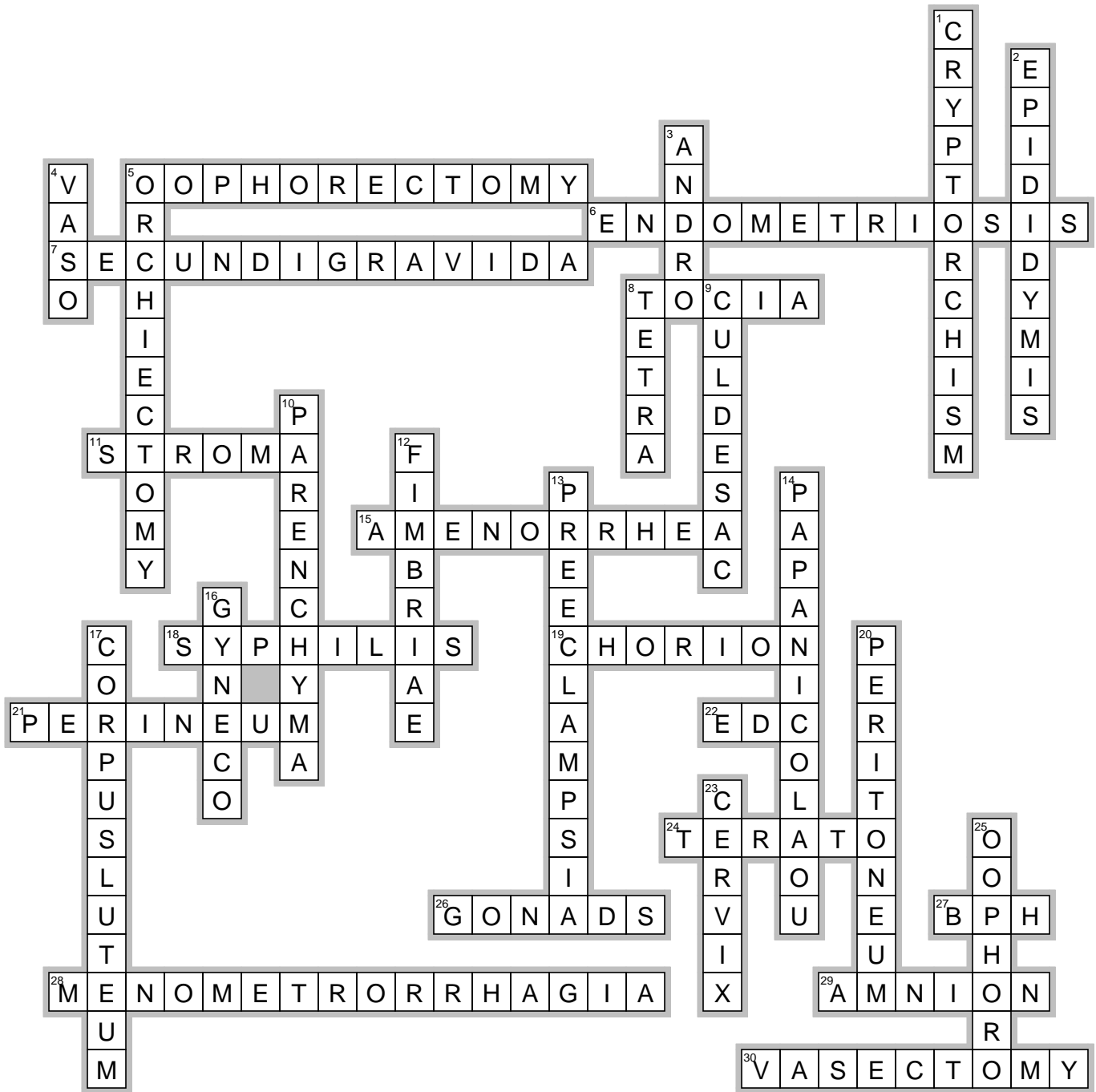

5. OOPHORECTOMY — Surgical removal of the ovaries
6. ENDOMETRIOSIS — Condition when tissue lining the uterus grows in other areas of the body, causing pain, irregular bleeding, and possible infertility
7. SECUNDIGRAVIDA — A woman who is in her second pregnancy
8. TOCIFORM — Suffix for labor or birth
11. STROMA — Supporting tissue
15. AMENORRHEA — Condition of having no menstrual periods
18. SYPHILIS — In its tertiary form, this disease characterized by insanity and blotches on the soles of the hands and feet

19. CHORION — Outermost membrane surrounding developing embryo; part of placenta
21. PERINEUM — Area between the genitalia and the anus
22. EDC — The baby's due date
24. TERATO — Combining form for monster
26. GONADS — Organs of sexual reproduction
27. BPH — Uniform enlargement of the prostate that prevents urination by blocking the urethra, is a benign condition that is treated surgically or with medication
28. MENOMETRORRHAGIA — Frequent, very heavy menstrual periods
29. AMNION — Innermost membrane surrounding developing embryo
30. VASECTOMY — Male sterilization consisting of excision of a small portion of the vas deferens
23. CERVIX — Lower, necklike portion of the uterus
25. OOPHORO — Combining form for female gonads that produce ova and hormones

1. CRYPTORCHISM — A condition that is a risk factor for testicular cancer
2. EPIDIDYMIS — A pair of tightly coiled tubes on top of the testes that serve as a maturation and temporary storage area for the sperm cells
3. ANDRO — Combining form for male
4. VASO — Combining form for the tube that carries sperm from the epididymis to the urethra
5. ORCHIECTOMY — Surgical removal of the testes
8. TETRA — Combining form for four (in number)
9. CULDESAC — Region located inside the pelvis between the uterus and the rectum
10. PARENCHYMA — The essential tissue that does the work of the organ; i.e. nerves are the parenchyma of the nervous system
12. FIMBRIAE — Fringelike structures at the ends of the fallopian tubes that catch the newly released ovum
13. PREECLAMPSIA — Pregnancy condition marked by high blood pressure, proteinuria, and edema
14. PAPANICOLAOU — The last name of George, the inventor of the Pap smear.
16. GYNECO — Combining form for female
17. CORPUSLUTEUM — Grows within the graafian follicle that produces progesterone and estrogen (2 words)
20. PERITONEUM — Lining around the inside of the abdomen
