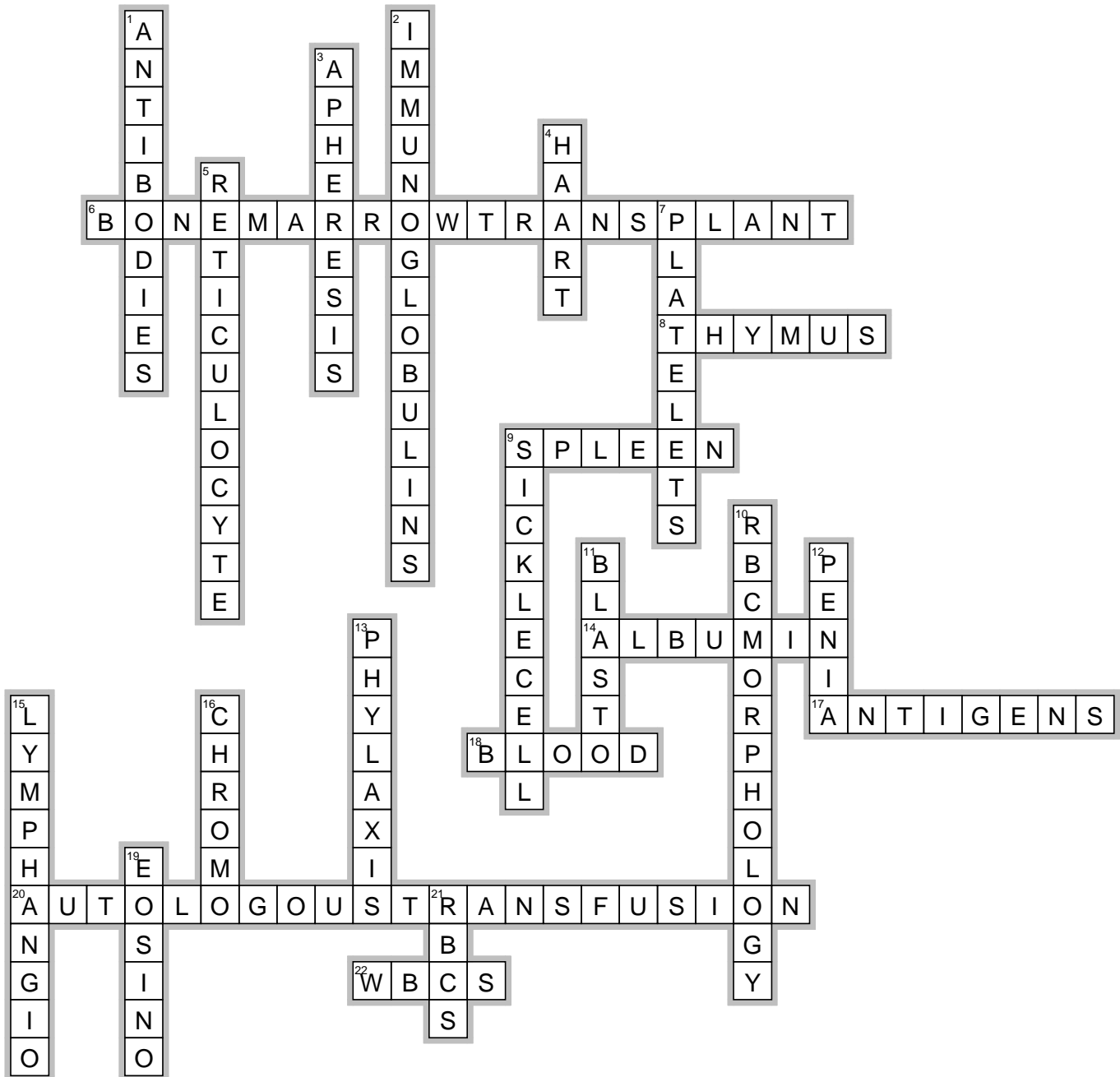

## Across

- 6. BONE MARROW TRANSPLANT — A needle aspirate of bone marrow from a donor who is a close blood and tissue match to the recipient is infused intravenously into the recipient patient (3 words)
- 8. THYMUS — Lymphatic organ that is important to immunity in neonates but less vital in adults; shrinks with age
- 9. SPLEEN — Organ in abdominal cavity that produces, stores, and eliminates blood cells
- 14. ALBUMIN — Plasma protein that helps maintain proper water balance in the blood
- 17. ANTIGENS — Foreign substances that are often toxic to the body or cells
- 18. BLOOD — Formed elements (cells) suspended in a clear, straw-colored fluid
- 20. AUTOLOGOUS TRANSFUSION — Blood cells are taken from a patient and then later retransfused to him or her as the need may arise (2 words)

22. WBCS — Normal range is about 5000 to 10,000 per cubic milliliter

1. ANTIBODIES — Agents that destroy harmful bacteria and foreign substances
2. IMMUNOGLOBULINS — Blood components capable of acting as antibodies
3. APHERESIS — Word part that means removal or separate
4. HAART — Medical treatment that changed the care of HIV-infected patients and significantly prolonged their average lifespans
5. RETICULOCYTE — Immature red blood cell
7. PLATELETS — Normal range is about 200,000 to 350,000 per cubic milliliter
9. SICKLECELL — Hereditary type of anemia characterized by hemolysis and abnormally shaped erythrocytes (2 words)
10. RBCMORPHOLOGY — Lab test where shape or form of red blood cells is examined (2 words)
11. BLASTO — Combining form for immature or embryonic
12. PENIA — Suffix that means deficiency
13. PHYLAXIS — Suffix that means protection
15. LYMPHANGIO — Combining form for vessel carrying clear, watery fluid circulated from tissues throughout the body
16. CHROMO — Combining form that means color
19. EOSINO — Combining form that means red, rosy, or dawn-colored
21. RBCS — Normal ranges are about 4 to 6 million per cubic milliliter
